Recognize the main challenges for Institutional Advisors; Develop the most important skills for an effective advising.

b. Registration

c. Language

The seminar will be held in English.

d. Classification

The overall classification of the seminar is: <u>UNCLASSIFIED Information</u> releasable to the Public.

e. Security measures

In order to receive the security badge that will be delivered during the registration procedure on the first day of the seminar, attendees will be required to present their military/civilian passport or ID card. This security badge must be carried throughout the event.

f. Visa Requirement

Participants, or their national authorities, are responsible for visa arrangements (if needed). Attendees are advised to contact, well in advance, proper diplomatic agencies for up-to-date information. It is the individual's responsibility to apply and obtain their visa and to have the proper travel documentation.

a. Medical service

No medical support will be provided by the NATO SFA COE. Medical expenses must be paid by the individuals or their insurance agencies. All attendees are strongly advised to have appropriate medical insurance.

h. Seminar tuition fee

The seminar fee is € 150.00.

The NATO SFA COE strongly encourages early payment of the seminar fee by bank transfer or using the payment link which will be sent to the selected attendees. On site electronic payments (POS) will be accepted on the first day of the seminar (**NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED**).

The information for the payment is detailed in the participation confirmation message will be sent to the selected attendees.

i. Accommodation
