AIM

The aim of the course is to improve the competency and effectiveness of SFA operators working in current and future missions of defence and related security capacity-building. The course enhances the practical understanding and application of NATO SFA operators working as part of a comprehensive and integrated approach. Course participants will be able to perform Security Force Assistance by advising, mentoring or training in order to improve the performance of designated actors.

- -NATO and Partner SFA Operators Advisers, Mentors and Trainers.
- -Military Officers (OF2 through OF5), experienced NCOs (OR6 to OR9) or civilian equivalents working as SFA operators in SFA operations.
- -NATO HQ IS/IMS, NATO Allied Command Operations (HQ SHAPE, Joint Force Commands, and Component Commands), NATO Allied Command Transformation (HQ SACT), COEs, NATO Force Structure and Potential Staff members.

ANNEX "C"

a. Course venue and time

The course will be held at the <u>Italian Army Infantry School</u> located in *Via della Stazione di Cesano, 423, 00123 Roma* (Italy).

The training hours are Monday 2 MAR to Thursday 5 MAR, 08:30 to 17:00 and Friday 6 MAR 08:30 to 13:30.

b. Registration

Applicants are kindly requested to fill in the registration form on NATO SFA COE website at https://reserved.nsfacoe.org/site/view?id=155 no later than **25 JAN 2026**.

c. Language

The course will be held in English.

Level 3 in English proficiency is required according to NATO STANAG 6001: Listening (3); Speaking (2); Reading (3); and Writing (2) or according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Language level B2-C1/Upper Intermediate-Advanced level).

d. Classification

The overall classification of the course is: <u>UNCLASSIFIED Information</u> releasable to the Public.

e. Security measures

In order to receive the security badge that will be delivered during the registration procedure on the first day of the course, participants will be required to present their military/civilian passport or ID card. This security badge must be carried throughout the event.

f. Visa Requirement

Participants, or their national authorities, are responsible for visa arrangements (if needed). Participants are advised to contact, well in advance, proper diplomatic agencies for up-to-date information. It is the individual's responsibility to apply and obtain their visa and to have the proper travel documentation.

g. Medical service

No medical support will be provided by the NATO SFA COE. In case of need, medical expenses must be covered by individuals or their insurance agencies. All participants are strongly recommended to have a proper medical insurance.

h. Course fee

The course fee is € 300.00.

The NATO SFA COE strongly encourages early payment of the course fee by bank transfer or using the payment link which will be sent to applicants whose attendance has been confirmed. On site electronic payments (POS) will be accepted on the first day of the course (**NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED**).

Failure to pay the tuition fee by the first day of the course will result in the suspension of the course attendance.

i. Accommodation

Participants are responsible to arrange their own accommodation.
